



# Student/Teacher Ratios

Imagine Learning has a full load teacher to student ratio that averages 29:1 for all core and elective courses at the middle and high school levels. Teachers typically have a 5 class period load. The ratios below are based on the full load totals for all five class periods.

Full time teachers have a maximum full load of 200 students.

Full Load Overall Student to Teacher Full Load Ratio: 24:1

- Full-time: 33:1
- Part-time: 25:1
